Expansive lawns, mature trees, dry-stone walls, courtyards and beds of roses and geraniums all add to the beauty of this large country garden.

Within the garden will be the added attractions of:

-  Sausage sizzle
-  Botanical artworks by well-known local artists
-  Plants, books and cakes stalls
-  Wonderful Werriwa Moo, Ewe and Pony Poo – a treat for any garden
